Late Rev. Fr. Cyriac Kottayil was the pioneer who paved the way for the present growth and development of St. Aloysius College. To commemorate his valuable contributions a new seminar hall is dedicated in his name at left wing in front of the Principal's office during the year.

RENOVATION OF THE COLLEGE OFFICE

To offer better service to the students, the college office was renovated by installing new cubicles and cabins and laying modern tiles on the floor. The counter size is enlarged and its position is shifted to the southern side for convenience.

RENOVATION OF REV. FR. PUNNAPPADAM HALL

Rev. Fr. Punnappadam Hall was renovated by laying modern tiles during July 2008: a new platform table too was installed in the hall.

INTERCOM SERVICE

The intercom service facility is replaced with a new EPABX system with capacity of 24 lines. This facilitates the easy internal communication between the various departments and the college office

XEROX MACHINE

As a supportive service to the student community, an additional Xerox machine is bought during the academic year and installed in the college library. It is quite convenient for the students to take photocopies of the books and the other materials.

LCD PROJECTOR

To promote the IT based teaching learning process in the college, an additional modern LCD projector was bought during the academic year.

RESEARCH CENTRE IN COMMERCE

The following research studies are going on in the research centre under the guidance of Dr. Zacharias Thomas:

1. 'Impact of Modern Retail Marketing System in Kerala'. Sri. Binu Mathew Job, Lecturer, Department of Commerce St. Berchman's College Changanacherry.
2. 'Effectiveness of Financial Inclusion Politics of Reserve Bank of India with special reference to Kerala'. Sri Renjith Jose lecturer, Department of Commerce St. Berchman's College Changanacherry.

Dr. Zacharias Thomas and Dr. K.K. Jacob are the approved research guides of the Research Centre.

COMPUTER CENTRE

The computer centre functions from 9 am to 5 pm on all working days. In addition to existing thirty computers, the computer center is upgraded with four new computers. Broadband Internet connectivity spread over 9 terminals connected by LAN is provided at the centre. Students enjoy the internet facility at concessional rate. Two year PGDCA Programme with special emphasis on Tally and DTP is conducted for the benefit of the students. Sixty students have registered for the course during the academic year 2008-09. The activities of the centre are co-ordinated by Dr. Indhulal G, Department of Mathematics and Prof. Jochan Joseph, Department of Physics.

ANTI RAGGING CELL

As directed by the State Government, an Anti Ragging Cell is constituted to prevent any sort of harassment to junior students. The cell is very vigilant in monitoring the activities of the senior students. No grievance has been reported in the academic year. The Cell functions under the co-ordination of Prof. Varghese Mathew, Prof. V.K. Koshy, and Prof. Tomcy Antony and Prof. Aniamma Peter.

ETHICS COMMITTEE

The ethics committee of the college is very vigilant in monitoring the practices of the ethical principles in the campus. As per the decision of the committee, the convener Dr. K.K Jacob engaged one hour each in each of the first year degree classes on the value systems to be followed in the college campus.

WETLAND STUDY CENTRE

Under the auspices of the Community Environmental Resource Centre Alappuzha, the Aloysian Wetland Study centre is functioning in the college with the objective of protecting the environment, particularly in the wetlands. Prof. Mathew Gregory and Prof. Marykutty Joseph are the co-ordinators. All the first and second year B.Sc. Chemistry and Zoology students are the members. An essay writing competition was held on 5th June 2008. Prof. Mathew Gregory attended the Teachers Workshop held at Alappuzha on 4th July, 2008. An awareness class was conducted in the college on 10th July 2008. A questionnaire was distributed among the students to assess their level of knowledge on the environment. Two students attended a workshop held at St. Joseph G.H.S. Alappuzha on 5th August 2008 and five students participated in the seminar held at St. Joseph College, Alappuzha on 26th August 2008. Two students participated in the student's workshop held at Community Environmental Resource Centre Alappuzha on 26th September 2008.

COUNSELLING CENTRE

In the present social scenario counselling is the need of the campus life. Counselling facility is provided to the needy students of our college. Counsellors from 'ACCEPT' visit our counselling centre on all Wednesday's. The centre has also organized seminars and lectures aimed at developing positive thinking among students.

CLUBS

DEBATING AND ELOCUTION CLUB

The debating and elocution club aims at developing the reading and oration skills of the students, enabling them to be good orators and thereby enriching their personality. The activities of the club were inaugurated on 22nd October, 2008 by Sri. Josekutty Sebastian in a meeting presided over by Rev. Dr Thomas Pothanamuzhi Principal of the college. A debating competition was conducted on the same day on the topic 'Present Educational System' Sri. Martin T. Kulangara (I B.Com.) and Kum.Tessy John (I B.Sc.
