Part B

COLLEGE ACTIVITIES 2009-2010

INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT

Tube well erection

Shortage of drinking water is a common problem in Kuttanad. In order to solve this issue in the college campus, the management has taken the initiative for the erection of a tube well in the campus in the beginning of the academic year. This ensures uninterrupted supply of water for the use of students and staff.

Trestle work for the roof

Due to the stagnation of rain water in the roof there was leakage in many parts of the main building. As a joint effort of the management and parent teacher association, aluminium roofing was installed in the western wing of the main building during the academic year.

New generator

Power failure is a common problem in the campus. In order to solve the issue to a certain extent a new generator was installed in the campus.

New Library Books

A new addition of 1000 volumes of books worth Rs.2,80,000 was purchased during the academic year with the financial assistance of UGC.

UGC Grant

The college received a special grant of Rs.80/- lakhs for the construction of a new women's hostel during the 11th plan. The college also received Rs.75 lakhs under the UG/PG and merged schemes of the UGC.

COMPUTER CENTRE

The Computer Centre functions from 9 am to 5 pm on all working days. In addition to the existing thirty four computers, the computer centre is upgraded with six new computers. Broadband Internet connectivity connected by LAN is provided at the Centre. Students enjoy the internet facility. Two Year PGDCA Programme with special emphasis on Tally and DTP is conducted for the benefit of the students. Forty students have registered for the course during the

academic year 2009 – 10. The activities of the Centre are co-ordinated by Dr.Indulal G., Department of Mathematics and Dr. Jochan Joseph, of the Department of Physics.

ANTIRAGGING CELL

As directed by the State Government an Antiragging cell was constituted to prevent any sort of harassment on junior students. The cell is very vigilant in monitoring the activities of senior students. No grievance has been reported in the academic year. The cell functions under the co-ordination of Prof. Varghese Mathew, Prof.V.K.Koshy, Prof.Tomey Antony and Prof.Aniamma Peter.

ETHICS COMMITTEE

A meeting of the Ethics Committee was convened on 26th August ,2009. As per the decision evolved in the meeting, the use of new identity cards was enforced in the college, effective from 14th September 2009. It was decided to ban the use of mobile phones in the campus and to confiscate the phones if used and also to impose a fine of Rs.100/- for the use. The students have to be introduced to the ethical rules of the college and Dr. K.K. Jacob engaged one hour in each of the first year degree classes for this purpose, making the students aware of the ethics of the college and significance and importance of abiding to these rules.

COUNSELING CENTRE

In the present social scenario counseling is the need of the campus life. The class teachers provide proper guidance and counseling to the needy students of our college. Sri. Georgekutty Augusthy, an expert counselor engaged a class on 10th February 2010. The students opined that the counseling centre of the college helps them to improve the inter – personal relationships. The centre has also organized seminars aimed at developing positive thinking among students.

DEBATING AND ELOCUTION CLUB

Achievements in life are very rarely a fluke, generally it is the culmination of years of committed hard work. It is a fact that all good education in essence is a process of developing the human personality. In a higher educational institution the latent talents and skills of the students are developed through various extra-curricular activities. The debating and elocution club of St.Aloysius College aims at developing the reading and communication skills of the students, enabling them to be good orators and thereby enriching their personality.

The activities of the club were inaugurated by Dr.P.C.Aniyankunju, principal of the college on 10th August, 2009. The club identified the talented students and groomed them to participate in elocution and debating competitions held in various colleges.
